REVISED MASS SCHEDULE FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST. The following Masses are suspended:

Sundays, 9:00 am at Most Holy Redeemer, Sawbridgeworth Sundays, 11:30 am at Holy Cross, Much Hadham Sundays, 6:00 pm at St Joseph and the English Martyrs

This means that there will only be three Sunday Masses as follows:

Saturday Vigil Mass at 6:00 pm, St Joseph and the English Martyrs Sunday, 9:00 am, St Joseph and the English Martyrs Sunday, 11:00 am, St Joseph and the English Martyrs

The weekday Masses are unaffected. There will still be a morning Mass at 9:30 am, Monday to Friday at St Joseph's, throughout August.

These changes are necessary to enable Fr Peter and Fr Antonio to go on their well deserved summer breaks. Fr Antonio is away during the first half of August while Fr Peter will be taking the second half of August off.

The normal Mass schedule will resume on Sunday 4 September.

If you know anyone from Sawbridgeworth or Much Hadham who will find it difficult to attend Mass at St Joseph and the English Martyrs Church, please do offer to give them a lift so that they can continue to fulfil their Sunday obligation throughout the summer.
