HERTFORDSHIRE FIRE AND RESCUE SERVICE

People may face new risks as they try to heat their homes differently to save on gas and electric bills.

Herts Fire & Rescue are offering free Safe and Well visits for those who most need them. If you have concerns about an older or vulnerable person, you can take a self-check questionnaire for them and book a Safe and Well visit through the system. Risks to look out for include smoking in bed, hoarding, and lack of working smoke alarms.

CERTIFICATE OF CATHOLIC PRACTICE
