PENTECOST SUNDAY

The First Reading describes the spectacular way the Holy Spirit made His entrance on Pentecost Sunday. The disciples were all in one place, and then a thunderous noise like a strong wind, like a tornado, came from the sky. Flames appeared out of nowhere, divided up and started floating through the air until they came to rest on each of the people gathered. All of a sudden, the Christians started speaking in languages that they didn't know. A crowd had gathered by now, with visitors from all over the world



who were in Jerusalem for the festival. Each one heard the Christians explaining the gospel in their own language.

Very dramatic ... but we would be wrong to conclude from this that the Holy Spirit's normal way of acting in our life is through dramatic fireworks. In fact, it's just the opposite. God's action in our life is most often gentle and hardly perceptible at first. The Holy Spirit does not bring fireworks and fancy balls into her life; it brings meaning, mission, wisdom, courage — virtues that take root and grow in the quiet centre of the soul, just as seeds take root and grow in the unseen darkness of the soil. Quiet, gentle, unseen, yet powerful, transforming, and everlasting — that's the work of the Holy Spirit.
