SOUL FOOD MONDAYS —During Soul Food in Lent (Mondays 24 and 31 March and 7 April), we will be running a five-part sycamore course, reflecting on some of the key aspects of our Catholic Faith. If you've never come before, there's always a first time - you'll find a warm welcome! We start the evening at 7.30pm, with refreshments served from 7.15pm and finish around 9pm.

NOTE TO ALL GIFT AIDERS —The HMRC requires that you must pay more income tax than the total of all Gift Aid amounts claimed in a tax year and the penalties for failure to comply with this rule can be severe. The 2024/25 tax year ends on 5 April and we will claim the Gift Aid for the tax year soon afterwards. If you are registered with the parish for Gift Aid and your circumstances have changed so that you are no longer eligible, you MUST inform us before 5 April please to ensure that our claims are correct. If you are not registered for Gift Aid with the parish but you are eligible to claim, please consider doing so as it will add 25% to your offertory donations without costing you anything. WHAT ARE THE SCRUTINIES? —The Scrutinies are Rites celebrated on the Third, Fourth and Fifth Sundays of Lent, by those who preparing to be baptised at Easter, known as "The Elect". They are important and special rites of the Church. Whenever they are celebrated, the Scripture readings of Year A of the liturgical cycle are used. The "Elect" along with their sponsors, kneel before the celebrant and the assembly, who pray for them silently with a series of intercessions culminating in a prayer of cleansing and protection with the laying-on-of-hands. Each Scrutiny is a step in preparing the Elect for the celebration and initiation soon to come. The Scrutinies are God's way of taking a close, loving look at the Elect. God does not scrutinise the Catechumens in order to find what's wrong with them but to celebrate all that's beautiful, good, and true in them. Jesus "scrutinises" us with Divine Light, revealing all that is valuable within each of us. He also reveals to us the ways in which we are hurting, or sick, or sinful. This is not to reject us, but to call us to new life and to healing. May these Scrutinies call both our Elect and us into the living waters of baptism, to the light of holiness, to a new life in Christ, through His Resurrection. The first Scrutiny Mass is this Sunday at 9am. Please keep our Elect, Sponsors, Catechists and Priests in your prayers.
