Youth Nights 2025-2026



The purpose of the Youth Nights is two-fold:

- SPIRITUAL: That we provide you with meaningful opportunities to grow in your relationship with God. This is often done during prayer times, with opportunities given to experience different ways of praying
- SOCIAL: That the events on offer would help build a greater sense of community, where you feel welcomed & valued as a young person in our parish

We also hope our youth nights would be relaxed and that what is offered would be enjoyable. You can participate as much or as little as you want.

Youth Nights take place on a Friday evening, once a month, from 6.30pm-8.30pm at the Windhill Churches Centre, just behind St Joseph's Church. They are for anyone of secondary age – those in school years 7-Year 13 (11-18 years old). Snacks and drinks are provided. On your first time coming, a parent or carer would need to fill in a consent form.

The evenings are a “drop in” style – meaning that you do not need to register or make a commitment for a whole year. Basically, you would be free to come to all of them, a few of them or just one of them, as you choose. Please note, most of the events will be free, but there may be the odd one or two that require a payment of some sort or that would require sign-ups in advance (e.g. an outing or special event). However, this would be communicated to you nearer the time.
